To all who shall see these Presents, Greeting:

Know Ye: That having special trust and confidence in the Wisdom, Discretion, and Learning of James S. Barber, of New Mexico; I have nominated, and by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, do appoint him United States District Judge for the District of New Mexico; and do authorize and empower him to execute and fulfil the duties of that Office, according to the Constitution, and Laws of the said United States, and to Hold the said Office with all the powers, privileges, and emoluments to the same of right appertaining, unto him, the said James S. Barber, during his good behavior.



In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made public, and the seal of the Department of Justice to be hereunto affixed. Done at the City of Washington, this sixteenth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-seven, and of the Independence of the United States of America the hundred and twentieth.
