NOTICE OF REASONABLE DEADLINE

All 10 x NOTICE OF BUDGET HEARING must be transmitted as email attachments in **.pdf** Adobe Reader format, in the same format and in the same content as the NOTICE OF BUDGET HEARING signed and dated May 29, 2019 *supra*.

Beyond that reasonable deadline, your silence will activate estoppel, pursuant to Carmine v. Bowen, and it will also constitute fraud pursuant to U.S. v. Tweel (*silence can be equated with fraud where there is a legal or moral duty to speak, or where an inquiry left unanswered would be intentionally misleading*).

Thank you for your timely cooperation in this long **PAST DUE** matter.
