Under separate cover we have mailed to your attention two (2) documents which the People of Douglas County regard as evidence calling for the conclusion that Mr. Paul E. Meyer suffers from conflicts of interest.

One document is a letter dated February 18, 2015 and attachments from Mr. Steve Gerlt. We believe that document speaks for itself.

The other document is a copy of the GENERAL JUDGMENT AND MONEY AWARD in the civil case of Saccato v. Douglas County, Case No. 02CV2351CC, in which the Douglas County Circuit Court found the Defendant liable to the Plaintiff for **breach of contract and breach of the duty of good faith and fair dealing**.

We are informed on reliable authority that Mr. Paul E. Meyer was primarily responsible for those breaches.

*Therefore*, the People of Douglas County cannot accept any participation by Paul E. Meyer in any form of appropriate dispute resolution ("ADR") technique to resolve their outstanding DOUGLAS COUNTY DAMAGES CLAIM dated May 24, 2017 A.D.
